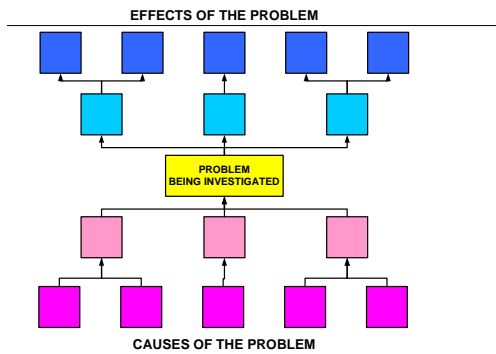

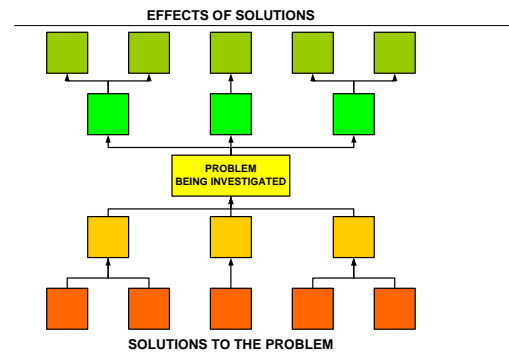
CLASSIC PROBLEM TREE

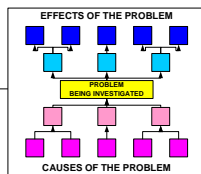

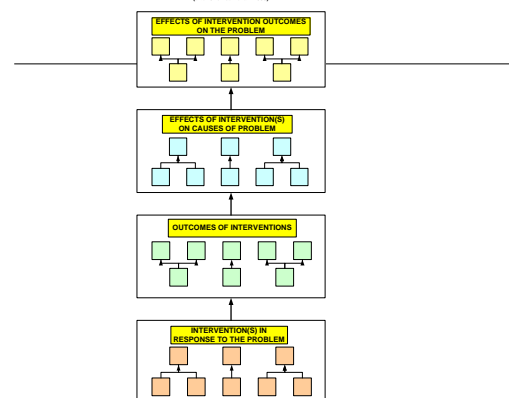

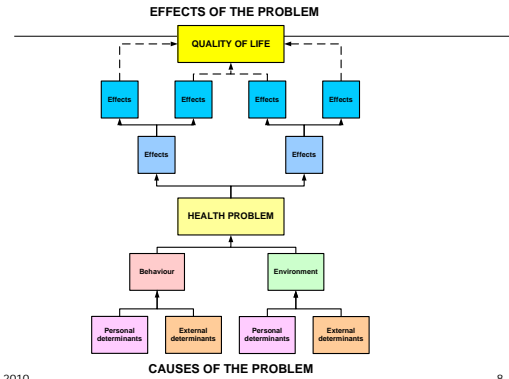

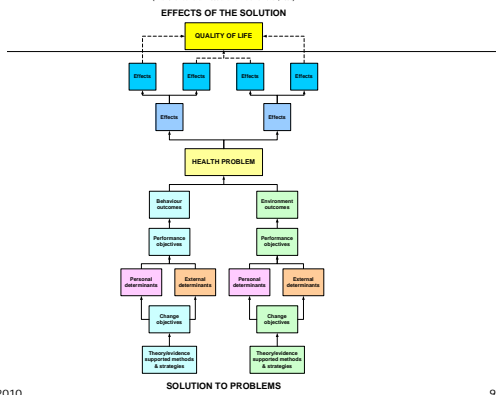
CLASSIC PROBLEM TREE:
